Time passes quickly and next year your child will be starting in school year 7, another big step in life. First we need to know which school you would like your child to go to; there are four secondary schools in the municipality. If your child already goes to Sollebrunn school and wishes to continue, there is no need to make a new application.

## Application

To apply for a school for your child you go to, use the municipality's website. You can choose up to 3 different school units. You can also apply for school transport using the e-service on the same website. <a href="https://www.alingsas.se/skolval">www.alingsas.se/skolval</a>

Send in your application between 15 November and 15 December.

Sometimes there are many applications for the same school and it is not always possible to provide enough places. Places are allocated in accordance with the municipality's placement rules; refer to the link below. If we are unable to provide a place at your chosen school, your child will be given a place at another school close to home. We always try to give you a place at your preferred school if at all possible.

There are special rules for school transport in the Education Act as well as those used by the Child and Adolescent Board. To be eligible for school transport, pupils in year 7 must live at least 5 km away from school by the shortest usable road. More information is available in the e-service.

Remember that you must apply for school transport separately. Please contact us if you are unsure how your choice of school could affect school transport.
